

Babylon Resident Parking Permits Available

Wyandanch LIRR Station Parking

Beginning September 1, Town of Babylon-owned surface parking lots at the Wyandanch Train Station will be made available exclusively to Town of Babylon residents with a free valid sticker permit. The lot at the northwest corner of Washington Avenue and Park Drive, previously scheduled to close September 1, will remain open indefinitely.

All Babylon residents may apply for a permit starting August 14, 2015. Applications will be available at the following locations:

- Babylon Town Hall, Wyandanch Train Station Parking Permit Office, 200 East Sunrise Highway, Lindenhurst
- Wyandanch Community Resource Center, 1585 Straight Path, Wyandanch
- Online at www.townofbabylon.com

Applicants will be asked to provide proof of residency in the Town of Babylon, as detailed on the application. Residents who return a complete and valid application to Town Hall will receive their permit at that time; all other applications will be collected and a permit mailed to the applicant if the application is valid and complete.


This parking restriction will apply to the following parking lots (see map):

- Andrews Avenue Parking Lot
- S 18th Street and Garden City Avenue Lot
