New York State CDBG-DR Application Available for Review

The Town of Babylon announces that it intends to submit an application for New York State Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program funds on or about November 30, 2016 for the following project:

Improvements to Potable Water and Fire Protection System – Gilgo and West Gilgo

Activity: The Town of Babylon is requesting Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funding for the following: In Gilgo, construction includes installing five drafting wells throughout the Gilgo community to minimize the distance between the fire wells and residential structures. In West Gilgo, construction includes raising the tops of wellheads, pump controls, filters, and other critical fixtures.

Objective: Implementation of the project will result in reduced risk of post-flooding electrical fire hazards for Gilgo residents and increased resiliency of West Gilgo's public water supply system on which the community relies for both fire suppression and potable water/domestic uses.

Location: West Gilgo and Gilgo, Suffolk County, NY

Amount: \$351,000.00 for Design, Construction, and Project Delivery Costs.

A copy of the application will be available for review at Babylon Town Hall, 200 E Sunrise Highway, Lindenhurst, NY 11757 during normal business hours.

All citizens, particularly persons of low- and moderate-income and residents of blighted areas, as well as those affected by the project are encouraged to submit their comments, views and proposals by November 29, 2016, *(this date must allow for a review period of a minimum of seven days prior to application submittal)* to the Town at the following address:
